



Program Description: The GVI Diversified Volatility Program utilizes systematic rule based trading systems with volatility and market risk control for long-term capital appreciation. The models utilize changes, especially in the term structure of Volatility Futures and other metrics in the Options and Volatility Markets. The systems adapt to changing market regimes and have been designed to achieve substantial diversification for traditional portfolios. This program uses models developed by GVI - Global Vision Investments AG complemented by models provided by a licensor for further diversification.

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

Statistical Notes

- 1. Peak to Valley Drawdown ("Maximum Drawdown") is the worst drawdown % loss over the period of 2019-01-31 to 2024-03-31
- 2. The Annualized Compounded ROR is the average return of an investment over a number of years. It smoothes out returns by assuming constant growth.
- 3. Calmar Ratio Uses last 36 months of Data
